REGISTRATIONS

Step 1 Register your entry/s online

REGULATIONS

General

- 1. Entry forms shall be signed by the exhibitor and give full contact details, description of exhibit and section and class number in which they wish to compete. Entry fees MUST be paid with the entry and lodged with the Secretary by the allocated time.
- 2. All Entry stickers MUST be affixed to the bottom left-hand corner of the show cage. No other markings will be evident on the show cage. Show cages must be of standard Suitable for Exhibit.
- 3. Exhibits must have enough food & water when they arrive, for the first day.
- 4. Exhibits will not be accepted without water and/or water bowl.
- 5. Collection times stated on the schedule must be adhered to. No vehicle access onsite during the event due to safety risks.
- 6. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving their reasons for doing so.
- 7. Any exhibit suffering from any infectious or contagious disease shall be reported immediately to the Section Manager who shall order its removal. The section manager must notify the Chief Biosecurity Officer if they have ordered the removal of an exhibit.
- 8. A business card can be placed on the cage for the purpose of future sales However no exchange can be made at the show.
- 9. Exhibits entered in the wrong class by the exhibitor may be transferred to the proper class by Managers/Stewards.
- 10. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show reserves the right to cancel or change any event or class or substitute a judge where or when deemed necessary.
- 11. All entries must be the Bona Fide property of the exhibitor on the date of entry. Entries are accepted entirely at owner's risk. Borrowing birds for show purposes or sales for limited periods will render both parties liable for disqualification.
- 12. For the duration of the show, all exhibits will be in the custody of the Chief Steward and shall not be touched or handled by the owner or any other person. Any exhibitor seen to be breaching this clause may forfeit their nomination and any prize money awarded.
- 13. Waivers must be signed and handed back to the Steward before the Rockhampton Agricultural Show takepossession of any exhibit for the duration of the show.
- 14. All prize money will be paid via cash payment during the exhibit collection times stated in the schedule. Any prize money not collected by 30 June 2025 will be forfeited and put towards the next year's Show.
- 15. Prize Money will be paid as:
 - a. Reserve Champions \$10.00, Champions \$20.00 and Grand Champions \$50
 - b. Sections being FINCH, CANARY, DOVE/QUAIL, PARROT, BUDGERIGAR, LOVEBIRD
- 16. All matters in dispute shall be subject to the decision of the Committee / Chief Steward / Section Managerappointed for such purposes.
- 17. No protest will be considered unless lodged with the Manager, in writing within one hour of completion of the event, enclosing \$50.00 which will be forfeited to the Rockhampton Agricultural Show should the protest be considered frivolous. Protests will only be received from competitors in the class in dispute.

- 18. Any person, whether competitor or not, who in the opinion of the Committee behaves in any offensive or threatening manner, either inside or outside, to any official or judge or member of the public, shall be liable to disqualification from further competition and shall be liable to be removed from the grounds.
- 19. Any exhibitor or his agent who shall make a false report and give misleading information or suppress necessary information respecting any exhibit shall be held to have forfeited any prize gained by these means. The exhibit and the exhibitor together with the agent may be disqualified and the matter referred to the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies.
- 20. All birds will be watered with bottled water supplied by the Rockhampton Agricultural Show.
- 21. Cages must be size appropriate for the bird in the cage.
- 22. Zebra Finches will be judged in correct class as Australian Finches

Additional Biosecurity Measures

- 23. The handling of animals must be in accordance with the Rockhampton Show Biosecurity Plan.
- 24. If the Chief Biosecurity Officer requests documents, information or directs a person to undertake an action, these requests must be complied with.
- 25. If an animal becomes ill it may be moved to the designated quarantine area, at the discretion of the Chief Biosecurity Officer or a Veterinarian.
- 26. If the on call vet for the Rockhampton Show is required the owner of the animal is responsible for payments to the veterinarian.
